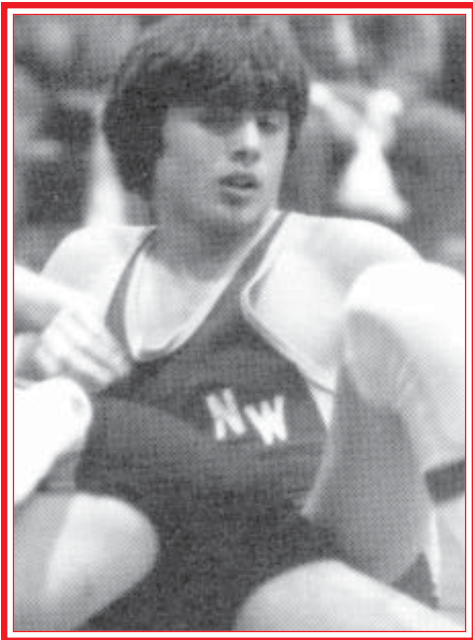

Bruce had an 87-11-1 career record at Northwest High School. He was the 1984 State Runner-up at 119 lbs. As a sophomore, he finished the season with a 30-6-1 record and was a sectional runner-up. He also won the Parkersburg, Lexington, and Northwest Tournament. Bruce set the school record with 21 pins. He was also a Senate League Champion and a Stark County All Star. During his junior year he compiled a 26-2 record. He won championships at the Orrville, Doylestown, Northwest and Senate League tournaments. He was a sectional champion, and placed third at the District Tournament. He capped off his junior year by placing sixth in the state and was again named to the stark county All Star Team. Bruce finished his senior year as both a District and Regional runner-up. He was a Doylestown Tournament Champion and placed second at the Northwest Invitational. He finished his senior year with a stellar 31-3 record and was named the Stark County Wrestler of the Year for his impressive record. Bruce and his wife, Melanie, live in Canal Fulton with their son, Hunter.
