Bill was a graduate of Clinton High School. He lettered in basketball and was known as the “peacemaker” if the opposing team tried to play mean. He was employed as a baker and worked with Ohio Brass of Barberton. He also had a Gravelly tractor business. He retired from East Ohio Gas with forty-four years of service. He was the police chief of Clinton for twenty-five years. During that time, he became the unofficial police authority at Northwest High School home varsity meets. This donated service started years before his three sons became members of the wrestling program. In 1973 and 1974 he organized two Luna Lake Steak Suppers. The money raised went 100% to send Northwest wrestlers to the Iowa Freestyle and Greco-Roman National Tournament. He was extremely supportive of his sons, Russ, Tim, and Dan, and never missed a match. He was a lifelong resident of Warwick and had six grandchildren.
