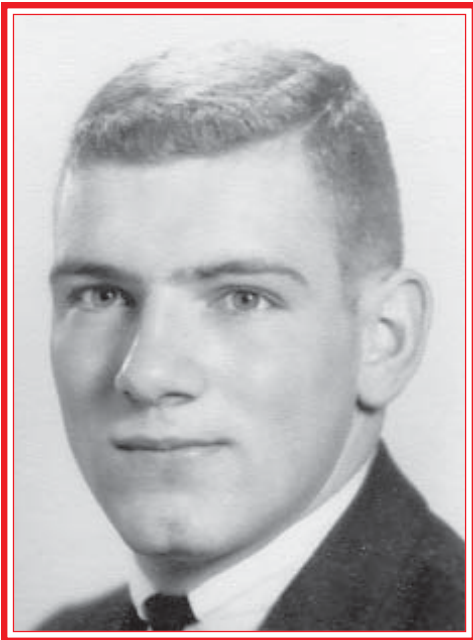


# NORTHWEST WRESTLING

Larry was a co-captain of Al Mayfield's first wrestling team his senior year at Northwest. He finished this inaugural season with a fine 14-1 record in the 175 pound class. He led the Indians in team points winning fourteen of fifteen matches with pins. The lone loss was the result of taking a forfeit at the 175 pound class and competing in the heavy weight division. He served as co-captain of the Indian Football team. He was named by the coaching staff as its Most Valuable Player. He was selected to the All-Stark County Class "A" and first team Stark County All Class Football teams. He was elected senior class president. He went on to graduate from Wittenberg University in 1967 with a teaching degree. While at Wittenberg, he wrestled one year. He was a four year letterman in football. His senior year he was elected Football Team Co-captain. He was named as member of the Ohio Conference and Lutheran College All American teams during his junior and senior years. He also served in the United States Army from 1968-1970. Larry completed a master's degree program at Ball State University in 1971.
