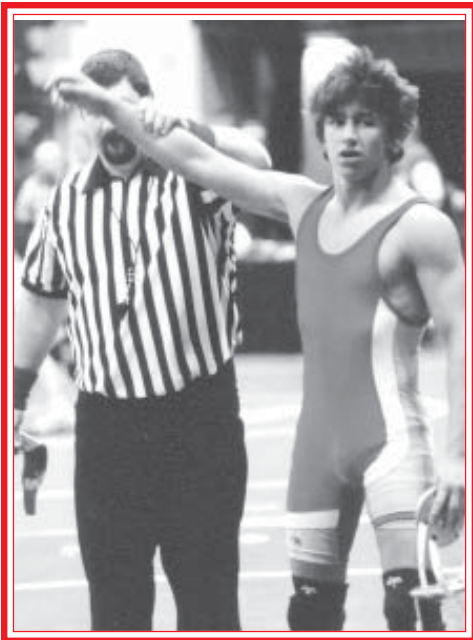

Anthony Naso was a two time state qualifier for the Northwest Indians. He was also a four-year letter winner and set school records for most takedowns in a season (148) and in a career (448). Tony finished his freshman season with a 14-14 record. He finished 4th in the sectional tournament that which qualified him to the Districts. Tony was also named to the 2nd team NBC and 3rd team All County for his efforts on the mat.

In 2001, Tony improved his season record (33-10) and led the team in takedowns (119). That season Tony placed 5th in the North Canton Holiday Invitational and 6th in the Medina Invitational. He won a Northwest Invitational championship at 112 lbs. and finished 3rd at the Bill Dies Memorial Tournament. Tony went on to become a Sectional Runner-up and placed 6th at the Firestone District. He was named 1st team NBC and 1st team All County.

He followed his impressive sophomore season with a breakout junior year. He compiled a 29-11 record, placed 6th at the Medina Invitational, won his 2nd Northwest Invitational championship, placed 5th at the Bill Dies Memorial Tournament, and won the Sectional championship at 112 pounds. His junior year was capped off by placing 2nd at the Districts which made him a first time, State Qualifier. For his junior year exploits on the mats, he was named to the 2nd team NBC and to the 1st team all county. Tony was selected team captain of the 2003 NBC championship team and as a senior, posted another fine 29-7 record. He won the North Canton Invitational, won his third Northwest Invitational title, and finished 3rd in the Bill Dies Memorial tournament. Tony was a Sectional and District runner-up that season and qualified for his second State tournament. He finished his stellar career with 105 career wins (7th all time) and was named 1st team NBC and 2nd team All County.

Tony is currently serving our country in the U.S. Air Force. He and his wife Elise reside in Dayton.
